Area	Outcomes	Next steps
Personal development	100% of children enjoy school, (82% most of the time or all of the time) 92% of children said teachers help them to do their best 100% of children said they felt safe at school 100% said they had an adult to talk to if they had a worry in school 97% of children felt encouraged to look after their physical health, 100% of Year 1 and 2 said they took part in trips and visits 98% would recommend the school to a friend	Discuss with children who do not always enjoy school what their barriers are
Curriculum and learning	85% of children felt they were given opportunities to extend their thinking and learning in learning 100% of children enjoy the topics they are taught 98% of children felt they knew the next steps for their learning	Focus on developing children understanding of 'challenge' in KS1
Behaviour and attitudes	- All children said that bullying either doesn't happen here (75%) or it does and teachers are good at dealing with it. 97% said they were encouraged to be independent and take responsibility for their learning 100% of children said they were encouraged to respect people from other backgrounds

Area	Outcomes	Next steps
Personal development	80% of children enjoy school the majority of the time with the further 20% enjoying school some of the time	

	• 85% of children said teachers help them to do their best in most or all lessons • 96% of children agree or strongly agree there is an adult for them to talk to in school if something is worrying them • 92% of children felt encouraged to look after their physical health • 93% of children felt encouraged to look after their mental health • 90% of children say they participate in school activities outside of lessons • 95% of children feel encouraged to be independent and take responsibility • 90% of children feel they have the opportunity to discuss their learning at school	
Curriculum and learning	• 81% of children say they are given opportunities to extend their learning and thinking in most or all lessons • 81% of children enjoy learning at The Gateway • 81% of children feel that teachers listen what they have to say in the majority of lessons • 94% of children can discuss a new skill they have learnt or something they have learnt to do • 82% of children enjoy the majority of topics with 13% enjoying some of the topics	Focus on developing enjoyment in learning - review learning talk discussions and creative approaches to develop enjoyment further 79% can talk about a designer or engineer - focus on raising the profile of key designers/scientists etc.
Behaviour and attitudes	• 95% of children say they feel encouraged to respect people from other cultures • 98% of children said that either bullying doesn't happen here or it does happen and teachers are either very good or good at resolving it • 94% of children feel safe the majority of the time at school
